The Current Dues Amount is 1% of Yearly Salary or 1% of Each Paycheck. CNM has 26 pay periods per year.

Here is a sample of how dues would be assessed from incomes in increments ranging between \$2,000 /year to \$100,000/year for each pay period. (We acknowledge that income almost never falls in increments like this. We are using these intervals here to give you an approximate idea of how much the deduction for dues will be.)

<u>Income per year</u>	<u>1 % of income</u>	<u>Dues Each Pay Period (26 per year)¹</u>
\$2,000	\$20 per year	\$0.77 per pay period
\$5,000	\$50 per year	\$1.92 per pay period
\$10,000	\$100 per year	\$3.84 per pay period
\$20,000	\$200 per year	\$7.69 per pay period
\$30,000	\$300 per year	\$11.50 per pay period
\$40,000	\$400 per year	\$15.38 per pay period
\$50,000	\$500 per year	\$19.20 per pay period
\$60,000	\$600 per year	\$23.00 per pay period
\$70,000	\$700 per year	\$26.92 per pay period
\$80,000	\$800 per year	\$30.76 per pay period
\$100,000	\$1000 per year	\$38.46 per pay period

I hereby authorize CNM to deduct from the compensation due me the above amount per pay period for twenty-six (26) pay periods per year as CNM Employees Union membership dues. I also authorize CNM to deduct from the compensation due me my membership dues as revised for the current year and each year thereafter. Dues deductions will continue unless revoked in writing by me to the CNM Payroll Department not later than 30 days prior to the proposed effective date of revocation.

Question: What is COPE?

Answer: COPE (Committee on Political Education) uses donations for political purposes in local and state elections. Donations made to our local COPE committee are used at the discretion of the committee -- namely, those individuals who donations have funded the committee. Generally, these funds are used to support the campaigns of candidates whom COPE members believe will best further educational excellence in New Mexico (and Albuquerque) and best promote the interests of educators and our union.

The Legal Stuff.

I hereby authorize CNM to deduct from compensation due me \$1.00 per pay period for twenty-six (26) pay periods per year. This authorization is signed freely and not out of fear of reprisal and I will not be favored or disadvantaged because I exercise this right. I understand this money will be used by the Committee to make political contributions. COPE is an independent PAC (Political Action Committee); it is NOT directed by CNMEU. This voluntary authorization may be revoked at any time by notifying COPE in writing. (Consult the CNMEU website for the current Chair of the committee.)
